

Printable Supplies:

-Resurrection Spinner

Resurrection Game Board (one per child)

Resurrection Game tokens (One full set of 12 per child)

Directions for set up:

Spinner: Print on Cardstock, Laminate. Insert Brad into arrow, then into center of spinner. See below for tips.

Game Tokens: Cut out, Laminate

Game Board: Cut out Laminate

Rules of Play.

Every child gets a Game Board. Set spinner in the middle, and all tokens in a big pile in the center. Each child takes turn spinning the spinner. Whatever picture they land on, they find and take the corresponding token from the middle. Have them place it on their game board (where ever they want). They can only have one of each token, so if they land on one they already have, it's the next person's turn. The game continues until each child fills their cross with the pieces. (or if you have older children, until the first person fills their cross) After they are all filled. read the Easter story, and have children hold up corresponding tokens when you get to that part.

Spinner tips from Homeschool hut

Here are a few tips to help you get the arrows to spin freely:

Place a metal washer between the arrow and the spinner with the brad going through them.

Use a very small piece of a straw underneath the metal washer to give the brad a hollow tube to spin in.

Fold the ends of the brad so that it fits loose and can allow the arrow to spin.

If all else fails, you can usually find plastic or metal arrows at a teacher/educational store.
