



Ring Toss / Cattle Rope Game

Prior to Class: Use horn patterns to make Cardboard Horns. Mount the horns to a chair so that they stick up in the air on either side. (you could paint them white if you need to, but cardboard is just fine)

Students: Color their own face for the steer, then cut out and mount on the chair so it looks like an actual steer.

Then students can use Butter Lids to play Ring Toss and try to catch a ring on the steers horns. Or you can even tie a string to the butter lid, and make it like a lasso, but warn the students not to try to pull them in, or they will break.

This would be a fun way to introduce the children to the class if they came in and their chairs had bull horns on them!

After the game you can use them as decorations around the class.

If it's too much work to make each child their own bull, you can make one or two and have the children take turns roping them. They could still each do an individual craft.....color their own bull, and then write their new verses or mottos on the horns.

You can also just print these and use them for decorations around your classroom, or to promote your VBS
